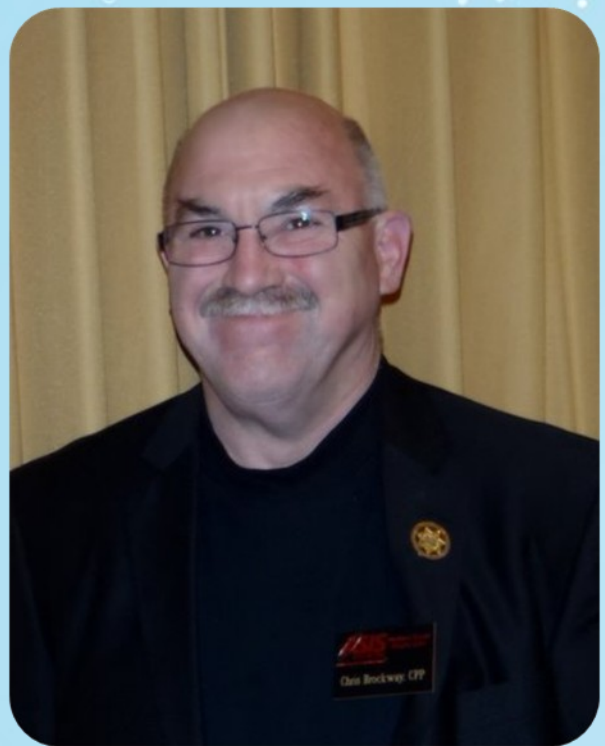

The drawing for door prizes was held and the meeting was concluded at 1300 Hours.

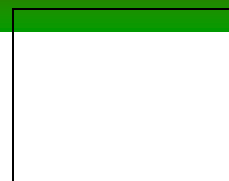
