VA Reimbursement Benefit for CPPs®, PSPs® and PCIs®

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) approved the CPP®, PSP® and PCI® exam for reimbursement through the G.I. Bill education benefits up to a maximum of \$2,000 per test can be recompensed in exam costs, but not to exceed the actual cost of the test. Benefits can still be received to retake a test that was previously failed. Electronic applications available online at www.gibill.va.gov OR call 1-888-442-4551 to request VA Form 22-1990.

All certificants may submit credit reporting forms with accompanying documentation at any time during their terms, and are encouraged to do so on an annual basis.

Important Notice

Recertification activities submitted by certificants in their Lapse Term (2011) or due to recertify by December 31, 2012 will be processed as soon as possible. Please send your documentation right away. Submissions from individuals due for

certification renewal at a later date (2013, 2014, and 2015) - will not be processed until January 2013.

This is due to the high volume of recertification form submissions that we are receiving for 2011 and 2012 recertification and the preparation process for our transition to a new database system that will be implemented next year. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.




